- A program of Habitat for Humanity International, Women Build enables women to help eliminate poverty housing by building homes and communities. Through Women Build, thousands of women volunteers and homeowners gain the confidence and skills to lay bricks, pound nails, raise walls and create hope.
- National Women Build Week, sponsored annually by Lowe's, challenges women from all walks of life to help eliminate poverty housing. Each May, during the days leading up to Mother's Day, thousands of women volunteers join in Women Build days at Habitat affiliates. National Women Build Week helps Habitat raise awareness and recruit more volunteers to accomplish our mission.
- In the U.S., more than 70 percent of Habitat's homes are built with women head-of-household. By receiving training as part of the Women Build program, they are better equipped to maintain their homes for themselves and their children.
- Habitat's WATCH Circle, "Women Accepting The Challenge of Housing." The WATCH circle serves as a vehicle to spread the word of the project and to help secure funding, it consists of 30 women throughout the Rogue Valley. Each woman has the goal to raise \$1,000 each either by giving or getting.
